M.Sc. Nursing Instructions

1. The candidates should be a Registered Nurse and Registered Midwife or equivalent with any State Nursing Registration Council.
2. The Minimum educational requirements shall be the passing of B. Sc.Nursing / B.Sc.Hons Nursing / Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing with Minimum of 55% aggregate Marks.
3. The Candidate should have undergone B.Sc.Nursing/ B.Sc.Hons Nursing / Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing in an institution which is recognised by Indian Nursing Council.
4. Minimum one year of work experience after Basic B.Sc. Nursing.
5. Minimum one year of work experience prior or after Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing.
6. Candidate shall be medically fit.
7. 5% relaxation of marks for Reserve candidates as per government rules may be given.
8. Selection of the candidate shall be based on the merit of an entrance examination. The question paper will be in English, Questions will be from B.Sc. Nursing / Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing Syllabus. There will be 60 questions of multiple choice (A, B, C, D) with single correct answer. Each question will carry one mark and there is no negative marking.
9. The Admission committee Saurashtra University Campus,Rajkot will prepare merit list of the candidates appeared for C.E.T.in accordance with the total marks obtained by them.
10. Copies of merit list will be displayed for information at the offices of the Saurashtra University Campus,Rajkot and its website.
11. In case two or more candidates obtaining equal marks in the C.E.T. the inter merit of such candidates shall be determined in the order of preference as under.
 - Then, the Candidate got higher external marks Last year University examination.
 - The candidate who have more working experience (Experience certificate must to show)
 - Then, the candidate older in age.
 - In case of all the equality between two or more candidates lottery system will be applicable.
12. Candidates are abide to follow Rules and Regulations as and when revised from Health & Family Welfare Department, Govt of Gujarat, Indian Nursing Council New Delhi, Gujarat Nursing Council Ahmedabad and saurashtra University, Rajkot for the said course.
13. Counseling shall be compulsory & shall be conducted by the committee consisting of

members as decided by M.S.C. NURSING CENTRAL ADMISSION COMMITTEE,
Saurashtra University Campus, Rajkot

14. The candidates should remain present for the personal interview (counselling) and for the spot admission as per calendar of event.
15. At the time of counselling, the eligibility of the candidate for admissions shall be verified from the original documents and eligible candidates will be interviewed and then for admission as per the availability of seats.
16. The candidates are to bring the Original documents. Failure to do this at the time of counselling, the candidate will result in instantaneous cancellation of his/her claim for admission and university/college will not be responsible for this.
17. Asking a candidate to report for counselling does not mean that he/she will be admitted to the course. The candidates will have to report for counselling personally at their own cost.

For Self Finance College:

18. Govt. Quota Seats - 75% of total seats as per rules and regulations of Reservation policy of Govt. Of Gujarat.
19. Management quota seats - 25% of total seats (Including Foreign Indian student (NRI) quota)
20. The seats remaining vacant in government quota shall be transferred to management quota and vice versa.
21. The Candidate those who will get admission through management quota shall have all eligibility criteria applied for entrance test.
22. No admission shall be made after Closure date announced by INC every year including left over seats.
23. Seats can be utilized in the same academic year only and any vacancy cannot be utilized in subsequent academic year.
24. The reservation in affiliated institutes will be as under
 - Government seats shall be reserved for the candidates and falling under the following categories, namely:
 - (a) Scheduled castes: 7%
 - (b) Scheduled Tribes: 15%

- (c) Society and Educationally Backward Classes including Widows and Orphans of any Caste: 27%
- (d) EWS: 10% of total seats as supernumerary in Government and government aided institutions only as per INC Notification dated 9/8/2019 No.1-5/2018-INC.
25. A Candidate seeking admission on reserved seats shall be required to produce a Certificate of Caste from which he/she originates: Provided that the candidate belonging to Socially and Educationally Backward Class shall be required to produce a certificate to the effect of non-inclusion in creamy Layer in addition to the caste certificate.
26. No caste certificate shall be valid unless it is duly stamped, signed and issued by the authority empowered by the Government of Gujarat.
27. No certificate to the effect of non-inclusion in creamy Layers shall be valid, unless it is duly stamped, signed and issued by the authority empowered by the Government of Gujarat. Such certificates shall have been issued on or after the 1st April of the academic year in which the candidate is seeking admission.
28. If a candidate fails to submit the certificates as required within the stipulated time, his candidate shall be considered for admission under unreserved category.
29. If a candidate of reserved category gets admission on unreserved seat in order of merits, he/she may be given admission on the unreserved seat according to his preference.
30. The admission of a candidate of a reserved category on a reserved seat shall be valid subject to the verification of caste certificate by the authority empowered by the state Government in this behalf. In case the caste certificate is found invalid on verification, he shall not have the right to claim his admission on reserved seat and if he has been already granted admission, such admission shall be cancelled.
31. After granting admission to all the candidates of reserved categories on reserved seats, the reserved category seats remaining vacant shall be transferred to the unreserved category seats.
32. For admission in M.Sc. Nursing reservation policy made by Gujarat Government will

be considered final.

33. In case of any complications or discrepancy, the decision by University authority will be considered final.

34. The University reserves the right to introduce any new rule or regulation or to make changes in any of the existing rules Regulations at any time to deal with diverse problems arising out of infinite variety of situation.
